Conditions of acceptance

Authors are expected to secure registration fees of 250 EUR + 19% VAT (150 EUR + 19% VAT for Students/ University Staff), travel and accommodation funding through their sponsoring organizations before submitting abstracts. Only original material should be submitted. There is no registration fee for authors organizing a tutorial.

Selection process

All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Advisory Board to ensure a high-quality conference. Submitted abstracts may be selected for oral or poster presentation. Notification about acceptance in December 2009. Submission of the full manuscript is on 5 March 2010.

Awards

Young Engineer Awards

Engineers not older than 35 years may apply for a young engineer award. The awards for the three best papers in this category are 1000 Euro each.
